Theme: "Comparing different methods for assessing bird diversity in deciduous and conifer forests"

We seek a highly motivated and passionate student to work with **bird identification through point counts** in different forest in Lower Saxony. The primary objective of the student will be to collect data about bird abundance and diversity during summer fieldwork period. It is also possible to transform the collected data into a Master Thesis.

We offer unique insight into a large collaborative research project: <u>RTG 2300 - EnriCo Project</u>, which has the overall aim to assess the ecosystem effects of mixing Norway spruce or Douglas fir with European beech.

Dates and working time:

Ideal start time between April and May. Flexible field days; fieldwork carried during morning only. Total between 40 and 80 hours of fieldwork

depending on candidate availability.

The position requires some experience with bird species identification through visual and auditory cues, and enthusiasm to do fieldwork on early mornings.

Application deadline: 31st of May. Notice that students will be selected on a rolling basis, so spots might be filled before this date; the sooner you apply the better.
